The above passage describes Paul's story in his own words, from his early days as a young Pharisee apprentice until God gave him a different assignment. In many ways, Paul's memories of who he was also impacted the kind of missionary to the Gentiles he became. After all, he was the one who used to persecute the Church of Jesus Christ.

Scrooge, in a sense had forgotten his own story. His trip down memory lane with the Ghost of Christmas Past helps him remember who he was. This is the beginning of his redemption.

I invite you to take a trip down memory lane. Could you write down your live story in 100 words? What kinds of memories would you include? Whatever they are, remembering them is the beginning of rediscovering that you came from somewhere and you have not always been this way.
